Write in a journal the inspiration for your picture/icon for each element

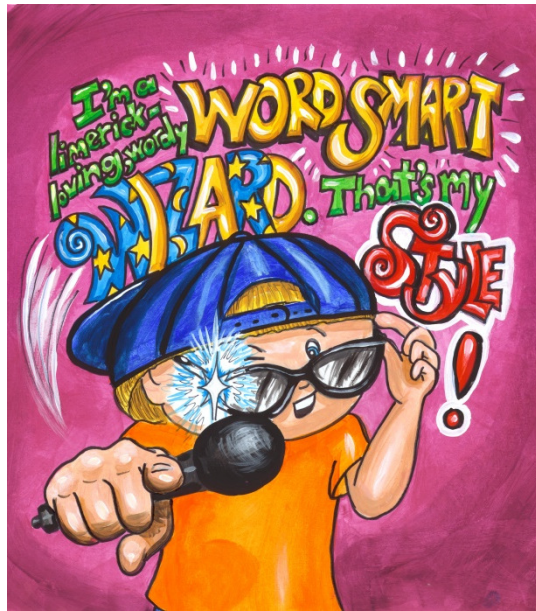
