Some ways . . .

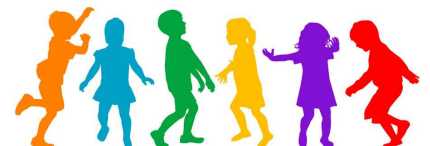
Sit in a circle. One person begins creating a story with the first line. Each person adds one line to complete the story!

to work on . . .

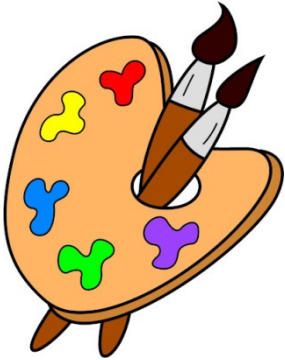
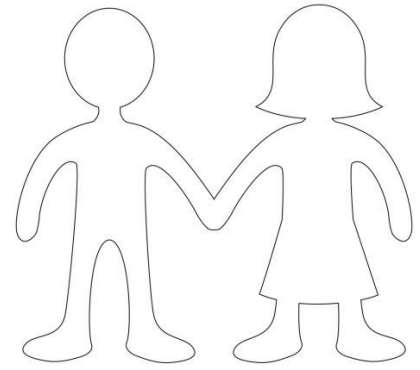
Gather a group of friends and identify a problem in your school and then discuss ways to solve that problem together.

PEOPLE SKILLS.

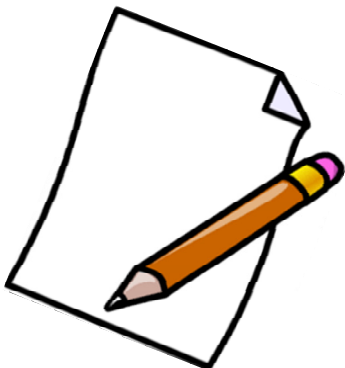
Sit and discuss with a group of friends what is special about your friendship and what are some things you need to work on to make it even better.
